The Gifts That We Receive

At Christmas we often receive a wide variety of gifts. In our family we have had the custom of a grab bag where people are invited to put in a gift and take out a gift. It is a common part of that exchange for some of our family to put in an occasional gift that is lovingly called a ZONK. These have included things like a worn-out vacuum cleaner; faces cleverly painted on Mr and Mrs Squash; gold-painted foam packing peanuts, mixed in with real peanuts; bottles of children's bubble bath; and numerous other embarrassing items. Yes, it is pretty silly of us to do such things. But part of Christmas is having fun and enjoying one another.

We don't let these gifts detract from the other gifts, the ones that really count. There is the gift of a family circled for prayer, thanking God for the blessings we have through the Christ-child. There is the gift of people re-connecting with those relatives we only see on occasion. We celebrate the gift of seeing how children and youth have grown in the past year. There is the gift of the cards and calls from friends both near and far away. There is the gift of new hope we receive in

the birth of the baby Jesus in the manger. There is the gift of new caring that Christ stirs up in our hearts so that we can give of ourselves to others.

Will I receive God's direction when I want to do things my way instead of listening for God's way? Will I be impacted by the force of God's love so that I will never be the same? I invite you to join me in this prayer for the New Year: O God, help me to become more receptive. May I hear your voice often each day. May I prayerfully listen for your leadership. May I be challenged and inspired by the presence of your Holy Spirit. Fill my heart with courage so that I will be bold to serve you. Fill my life with grace as I relate to those around me. Grant me an awareness of the unique abilities you have instilled within me. Enable me to put these to use for your sake. Thank you, God. Even now, I am receiving your wondrous gifts. All praise to you, in Jesus' name. Amen.

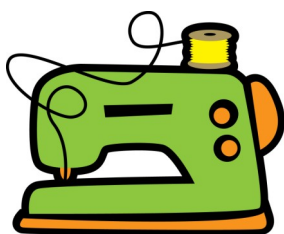

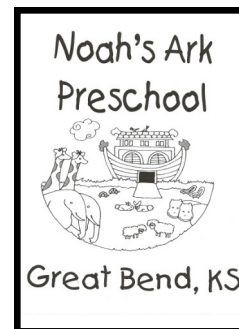

2010 MINISTRY & OPERATIONS

Worship

Our Pastor and Worship Committee provide for the life of our congregation. Preparing sermons, and planning for Sunday morning worship through God's word, music and prayer, is a special dispensation of God's grace. Our pastor extends God's love to those in all manner of situations: illness, counseling, planning weddings and counseling the new couple, conducting funerals, bereavement, life transitions, discerning God's call, Bible studies, and many more.

Christian Education and Training

Our director and volunteers provide fellowship, teaching and mission involvement opportunities for our youth. Volunteers commit their time to providing weekly Bible study for children and adults. Bible materials are provided to learn God's ways, and how to grow in our faith. Mission activities are provided throughout the year. Our pastor provides oversight and guidance to these areas.

Outreach and Visitation

Advertising is one way we tell the community who we are, and of opportunities available to them. Outreach includes visitation of those who are first time visitors of our church, getting to know them and their needs, and visiting each other. Forest Street Café reaches out to families with a different type of worship and fellowship.

United Methodist Conference Mission and Ministry

Helps provide pastors to congregations; supports the administrative work of the Conference; supports world wide evangelism and missionaries; helps feed and clothe the needy; funds the camping ministry; sends Volunteers in Mission throughout the U.S.; provides for seminary scholarships and continuing education; supports thirteen U.M. seminaries; provides funding for Kansas Wesleyan University and Southwestern College, Methodist Youthville and other institutions.

Administrative Support

The secretary and business administrator provide direct support for our pastor, youth director, teachers, committees, and members. Copiers, paper, postage and supplies are provided in support of all areas of the church. Bulletins, newsletters, and brochures are designed and printed. Facilities

Utilities and maintenance help provide a comfortable and beautiful place for worship, fellowship, learning and ministry. Our custodian and Trustees provide excellent care of the facility. Insurance helps provide a safer environment. Equipment such as piano's, organ, kitchen appliances, projectors, etc., are provided for use in teaching, worship and fellowshiping.
